At 5:00 PM, Tropical Storm Edouard was located at 29.8 N and 79.2 W with sustained winds of 50 mph and is moving WSW near 6 mph. A continued motion to the WSW is forecasted over the next 24 hours and Edouard is expected to make landfall near Daytona Beach, FL.

Edouard is not forecast to become a threat to Chatham County. Accordingly, CEMA will return to normal Operating Condition (5).

CEMA will continue to monitor this storm and alert you to any significant change that would prove a potential threat to Chatham County.

This will be the last Situation Report issued for this event unless events warrant otherwise.
