



## INFORMATION RELEASE

**Tropical Depression Kyle**  
**10 October 2002**  
**4:00 PM**

At 11:00 AM a Tropical Storm Watch was issued from Cocoa Beach, FL to Brunswick, GA. A tropical storm watch indicates that tropical storm conditions are possible in the watch area within 36 hours.

As of the 2:00 PM intermediate advisory from the National Hurricane Center, Tropical Depression Kyle was located at 28.5 N and 78.6 W or about 120 miles east of Cape Canaveral, FL. The TD is moving toward the west near 13 MPH and a gradual turn toward the WNW and NW is expected during the next 24 hours. Maximum sustained winds are near 30 mph with higher gusts. Some strengthening is possible during the next 24 hours.

Under the current forecast, Chatham should begin to experience an increase in wind by noon Friday with maximum winds beginning around 8:00 PM tomorrow evening. Maximum sustained winds of approximately 30 MPH should be short lived as the storm moves through the area. Rainfall in the amounts of ½" to 1" is expected for the duration of the storm.

Due to the proximity of the storm, this notification is being taken as a precautionary measure. All interested parties should maintain vigilance in monitoring the development of this storm.

The next report will be issued at 9:00 AM tomorrow morning unless conditions warrant otherwise.
