## INFORMATION RELEASE

**SEVERE WEATHER**  
JULY 24, 2003 – 3:30 PM

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN CHARLESTON HAS ISSUED A FLASH FLOOD WARNING FOR CHATHAM COUNTY UNTIL 4:45 PM. AT 3:13 PM RADAR INDICATED VERY HEAVY RAIN FALLING ACROSS MUCH OF CHATHAM COUNTY. RADAR ESTIMATES BETWEEN 2 & 3 INCHES OF RAIN HAS FALLEN OVER THESE AREAS SINCE 2 PM. WITH AN ADDITIONAL 1 TO 3 INCHES POSSIBLE. THE RISK FOR FLASH FLOODING IS HIGH.

DO NOT DRIVE YOUR VEHICLE INTO AREAS WHERE THE WATER COVERS THE ROADWAY. THE WATER DEPTH MAY BE TOO GREAT TO ALLOW YOUR CAR TO CROSS SAFELY.

LOCALLY SEVERAL AREAS ARE FLOODED AND SHOULD BE AVOIDED. THESE INCLUDE:
