## SITUATION REPORT #6

### Hurricane Frances

September 4, 2004 11:00 am

Hurricane Frances has been downgraded to a category 2 hurricane and is beginning to impact the coast of Florida. Rainfall and windy conditions should begin to move into our area late Saturday night and Sunday.

CEMA will return to normal Operating Condition 5. CEMA will continue to monitor this storm and alert you to any significant change that would prove a potential threat to Chatham County.

Please review and update your individual emergency plans. Prudent recommendations during hurricane season should contain the following:

- Review insurance coverage
- Locate important documents and make them readily available
- Ensure medications are refilled if appropriate
- Be familiar with evacuation routes outside of Chatham County
- Identify primary relocation destination and a backup
- Make contact and assist elderly family members, friends and neighbors

As of this time, CEMA does not know of any relief efforts for Florida residents. However, stay tuned to your local media for future information .
